## Beyond the Yellow Ribbon Committee Meeting November 17, 2011

Meeting called to order by Obach at 8:30.

New members were introduced. Russ Richards presented the mission of Rebuilding Together.

Hunt reported on the Public Safety plan. Moorhead PD and Fire are willing to distribute business cards for BTYR with our message.

Tom Figliuzzi offered the Clay County Veterans Service Office to use the backside of the VSO business card to have the Yellow Ribbon contact information be listed on the same card. The rationale is that each county has a VSO and they are well established veteran entities for the community, especially due to the fact that each VSO has a constant presence of staff. If the committee agrees that they would want the contact information published with the Clay County VSO, and it is so voted to do so, the BYTR would then provide the VSO the yellow ribbon contact information for printing on their business card. The VSO stated that this is conditional as: There must be a clear handoff once a call comes in for the Yellow Ribbon. If that handoff does not happen then the VSO would have to cease serving as that focal point as the VSO cannot be performing the function of the Yellow Ribbon from his office. Sjostrom volunteered to have his office listed on the card.
